**Instruction Sheet for Articles of Incorporation for Domestic Limited Cooperative Association
Form DLCA-1, Version 1, January 2012.**

Use this instruction to draft articles of incorporation for your association; or use the fillable Articles of Incorporation on page 2. This will establish your new Domestic Limited Cooperative Association in the District of Columbia.

ENTITY TYPE	FILING FEE
Domestic Limited Cooperative Association.	Refer to Corporate Fee Schedule posted online.

The following information is required for articles of organization.

1.
The name of the association. The name of a limited cooperative association shall contain the words "limited cooperative association" or "limited cooperative" or the abbreviation "L.C.A." or "LCA". "Limited" may be abbreviated as "Ltd. ". "Cooperative" may be abbreviated as "Co-op.", "Coop.", "Co-op", or "Coop". "Association" may be abbreviated as "Assoc.", "Assoc", "Assn.", or "Assn".
2.
A statement as to the purpose or purposes for which the association is formed.
3.
The term of existence of the association, which may be perpetual.
4.
The location and address of the principal office of the association.
5.
Registered Agent's name and address in the District Columbia. (review Registered Agent Combined Form for more information)
6.
Miscellaneous Provision.
7.
Organizers names and address; each Organizer must sign and date the articles.

One or more persons acting as the organizers under the provisions of the Title 29 of D.C. Code (Business Organizations Act) adopt the following Articles of Organization:

1. Association Name.
2. Association Purpose.
3. Term of Existence.
4. Principal office address.
5. Registered Agent's name and address in the District Columbia.
6. Miscellaneous Provision.

If you sign this form you agree that anyone who makes a false statement can be punished by criminal penalties of a fine up to \$1000, imprisonment up to 180 days, or both, under DCOC § 22-2405;
