Motoko Aizawa is an Advisor to the Sustainable Development Network at the World Bank and is currently a member of the District of Columbia Commission on Human Rights.

Motoko Aizawa is an expert on environmental, social, and governance dimensions of sustainability, as well as policy initiatives to help governments and companies improve their sustainability performance, particularly in the financial extractives sectors.

She is the principal author of the 2006 IFC Performance Standards, and the human rights provisions in the 2012 version of these standards. Until recently, Ms. Aizawa led efforts by the World Bank to update its Environmental and Social Safeguard Policies.

A Ward 3 resident, Ms. Aizawa received a Bachelor of Arts in History from the Hamilton College, and a Master of Laws in Public and Private International Law from the University of London.
